## From Pastor's Pen

I charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom: <sup>2</sup> preach the word; - II Timothy 4:1

St Timothy was a leader in the Church at Lystra when Paul and Silas visited there. From that moment, Timothy was called to become Paul's companion and partner in minisgtry. They traveled together throughout Asia Minor, and eventually visited Ephesus, where Timothy was appointed to shepherd the church there as Paul continued his missionary journey that would eventually lead to Rome.

It is the way of the Lord to create leaders, to call them to places of His design, and to bless those left behind. That is what is taking place now. My time and work among us has come to an end.
